

Economic Development News

A number of companies have recently decided to locate and expand in Cheshire, thereby adding to the town's growing and diverse business community. The Economic Development Commission is pleased to have these companies of high quality in the Town of Cheshire.

Napoli Foods constructed a 120,000 SF warehouse facility off Knotter Drive. A distributor of food products, Napoli commenced construction last spring. Napoli will employ 70 in Cheshire.

PA Sports Ticker, a real-time sports news information provider serving North & South America, Europe, and Asia, moved its headquarters to Cheshire. PA Sports Ticker leased 15,000 SF at 55 Realty Drive. A 24-hour operation, the company has 100 employees.

Dr. Thomas Chin opened Sandbank Veterinary Hospital off Sandbank Road with an initial staff of 6. This newly constructed 4,000 SF facility provides medical and surgical small animal services.

Powerstation received approval to construct an 8,000 SF addition to its facility off Highland Avenue. The company specializes in entertainment services including DJ, video, photography, lighting, staging and sound.

Salsco completed a 9,200 SF addition to its 31,000 SF building off Sandbank Road. The company is a manufacturer of outdoor power equipment for the turf and landscape, nursery, tree care and farm industries.

Lane Construction purchased a 70,000 SF office building at 90 Fieldstone Court for its corporate headquarters. Lane, one of the nation's largest heavy civil and transportation contractors, moved 100 employees to Cheshire.

551 West Johnson, LLC received approval to construct three buildings totaling 78,000 SF for industrial condominiums on property at 1484 Highland Avenue. The first building of 30,000 SF is under construction.

TJM Environmental Restoration received approval to construct 41,000 SF of industrial flex space on 8 acres at 300 East Johnson Avenue.

Whitright Realty, LLC completed construction of an 11,000 SF dog kennel and grooming facility (PAWS Pet Resort & Spa) on property at 312 East Johnson Avenue.

Cheshire Route 10 LLC received a zone text change approval and submitted applications for a zone map change, aquifer protection and earth removal permits and zone change approvals for a mixed-use development on 100 acres at Route 10 and I-691. Project calls for a lifestyle center, cinema, health & fitness facility, hotel and 160 two-bedroom residential units. **Plans are available for review in the Cheshire Public Library and Planning Department.**

V-Technologies, a company specializing in shipping automation software, purchased an 8,000 SF office building at 675 West Johnson Avenue and moved its 25 employees to Cheshire.

Cheshire ILMR, LLC received approval to construct a 14,000 SF CVS on the Cheshire Shopping Center property off South Main Street.

True World Foods purchased a 7,600 SF building at 2091 Meriden Road which serves as the company's regional food distribution center.

Creative Dimensions leased 59,000 SF at 345 McCausland Court and will move 50 employees to Cheshire. The company designs and builds exterior & internal signs and custom & portable exhibits.
