Sealed bids for construction of the Mixville Sewer Pump Station Upgrade will be received at the office of the Water Pollution Control Authority, Town Hall, 84 South Main Street, Cheshire, CT 06410 until 10:00 AM, local time, January 13, 2010, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids submitted after this time will not be accepted. Each bidder must submit a single sealed envelope, the outside of which must be clearly marked "**Bid for the Water Pollution Control Authority, Mixville Sewer Pump Station Upgrade**".

The Project consists of, but is not limited to: site work, architectural, mechanical, HVAC and electrical upgrade, paving, concrete and instrumentation complete and operational.

Copies of Contract Documents including all addenda may be obtained at the office of the Department of Public Works, Town Hall, 84 South Main Street, Cheshire, CT 06410, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of \$75.00 per set. Partial sets will not be distributed.

To be considered a responsive Bidder, the Contractor shall have obtained at least one complete set of paper plans and specifications from the Town of Cheshire Water Pollution Control Authority. The Bid will not be awarded to a Bidder unless a record for the purchase of at least one complete set of paper plans and specifications exists in the office of the Owner. To meet this requirement and to establish the record of purchase, a prospective Bidder must purchase a complete set of paper plans and specifications using the name that is to appear in the bid documents.

A pre-bid conference will be held at the Cheshire Town Hall on December 17, 2009 at 10:00 AM. Attendance is encouraged, although not mandatory.

The Responsive Bidder must submit the following with the Bid:

1. Completed Bid Form (Section 00310).
2. Completed Experience Statement (Section 00405).
3. Completed Addendum to Bid Proposal (Section 00406).
4. Completed Certificate of Bidder Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity (Section 00407).
5. Completed Non-Collusion Affidavit (Section 00408).
6. Bid Security as described below.

Bid Security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the Total Bid must be submitted with the Bid. The Bid Security may be a proposal guaranty bond executed by a surety company authorized to do business in the State of Connecticut. Bids submitted without Bid Security will not be considered. No Bid may be withdrawn within 60 days after receipt of Bids unless released by the Owner.

The successful bidder must furnish the Town, within 15 days after the Notice of Award, a complete list of sub bidders, five (5) signed Agreements, a 100% Performance Bond; a 100% Payment Bond; and proof of insurance documentation, as specified. Prevailing Wages: The Contractor must comply with Section 31-53 of the Connecticut General Statutes as amended, including annual adjustments in Prevailing Wages.

The Town of Cheshire reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive any technical or legal deficiencies and to accept any Bid that it may deem to be in the best interest of the Town.
