Cheshire Recreation is excited to announce that the Greg Schena Memorial Ice Skating Rink at Bartlem Park is now open! Ice skating is free to the public; you are required to bring your own skates and protective gear. The rink will be open Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., and Saturdays and Sundays from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (hours subject to change). The skating area is unsupervised. Use of rink is "At Your Own Risk" and parents/guardians are responsible for children. Helmets and protective gear are strongly encouraged. The rink is intended for recreational skating use only; sticks and pucks are not permitted on the ice rink.

On Thursday, January 18, 2018 (make-up date January 25, 2018) from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m., the Cheshire Recreation Department will be hosting a Special Family Night at the rink which will include music, free hot chocolate (while supplies last) and pictures with Olaf the Snowman from Frozen!
