

## **GREG SCHENA MEMORIAL ICE RINK RULES and REGULATIONS**

- The Greg Schena Memorial Ice Rink will be open Monday-Sunday from dawn to 9:00pm, weather permitting.
- The Cheshire Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to close the facility for any circumstances it deems necessary.
- Please check [www.cheshirect.org/parkrec](http://www.cheshirect.org/parkrec) for closure announcements.
- The skating area is unsupervised. Use of rink is “At Your Own Risk”.
- Parents/Guardians are responsible for children.
- Ice skates must be worn on ice at all times. Skates should immediately be removed once exiting the area.
- Please consider others when skating. Skate under control at all times
- Helmets and protective gear are strongly encouraged. Use of helmets and protective gear will reduce your risk of injury
- No food or drink allowed on ice. All trash must be placed in designated containers.
- Sticks and/or pucks are not allowed on the rink at any time.
- Animals are not permitted on the ice rink.
- The Department may restrict entry to the facility and ask persons to leave the facility if any of the rules are not followed or inappropriate behavior is observed.
