- **Car Seats-** Officers conducted a total of five (5) child safety seat inspections in December
- **Serious MVA-**Nothing to report.

- Residential Burglary-On 12/3 Detectives began an investigation into a residential burglary that occurred on Far Horizon Dr. Access to the home was gained through a garage door opener in an unlocked motor vehicle, two motor vehicles and other items were stolen.
- Commercial Burglary-
 - On 12/14 Detectives began an investigation into an attempted commercial burglary at 1125 Highland Ave, English Service Center. A window was smashed and a rock was located inside, but it does not appear as though entry was achieved and no items were reported stolen.
 - On 12/26 Detectives began an investigation into a commercial burglary at 901 W. Main St, Shell Gas Station. Smash and grab type, theft of cigarettes. A suspect has been identified and the investigation continues.
- Death Investigation-On 12/23 Detectives began an investigation into an untimely death at 387 Mixville Rd. The individual was transported to the hospital where she was pronounced deceased. The Office of the Chief Medical Examiner conducted an autopsy and the investigation will remain open pending autopsy results.
- Juvenile Investigation-On 12/5 Detectives began an investigation into a possible domestic situation stemming from a medical call. The situation was deemed non-criminal and the case was documented and closed.
- Other Crimes-On 12/21 Detectives began an investigation into a report of an unlawful discharge of a firearm at an Oak Ave residence. A search warrant was granted and executed, and an arrest warrant is pending.

- Sexual Assault-On 12/28 Detectives began an investigation into a report of a sexual assault that occurred on 12/25 at a Waterbury Rd address. This investigation is ongoing.
- Motor Vehicle Thefts-
 - On 12/3 two motor vehicles were stolen in association with the above listed residential burglary.
 - On 12/27 a motor vehicle was stolen from a Waterbury Rd address. The vehicle has since been recovered in Waterbury.
- Theft from Motor Vehicle/Tampering
 - There were 16 reported thefts from motor vehicles in December, and 5 reported tampering with motor vehicles.
