- **Car Seats-** Officers conducted a total of eight (8) child safety seat inspections in November
- **Serious MVA-**Officers responded to a motor vehicle accident at Peck La in the area of Westmore Rd. Minor injuries reported. The accident is still under investigation.

- **Commercial Burglary:** Detectives began an investigation on 11/1 into a burglary of Deli 66 located at 1156 Meriden Waterbury Turnpike. Entry was gained by force through the front doors of the business, minor loss reported as well as the damage to the door.
- **Arson:** Detectives began an investigation in conjunction with the CFD Fire Marshall's office into a possible arson fire that occurred on 11/15/2018. A trash collection truck caught on fire while parked in the yard of 12 Putnam Pl.
- **Narcotics:** Detectives began an investigation into the possible sale of Narcotics/Contraband substances from a local business. The investigation stemmed from an anonymous tip and is ongoing.
- **Sex Assault:** Detectives began an investigation on 11/19 into a complaint of a past sexual assault.
- **Other Crimes:** On 11/19 Detectives began an investigation into a possible harassment/threat at 3 Main St, Temple Beth David following the receipt of a troubling email by personnel there. The case was closed as non-criminal, and was handled as a juvenile matter.
- **Residential Burglary:** On 11/21 Detectives began an investigation into a residential burglary at 1109 Waterbury Rd. Forcible entry was made and firearms and other valuables were stolen.

- **Tobacco Compliance:** On 11/27 Detectives worked with the State of CT Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services on Tobacco Compliance for area businesses. An underage participant attempted to buy tobacco products from thirteen Cheshire establishments. One violation occurred and personnel at 197 Main St were cited for the infraction.
- **Motor Vehicle Thefts:**
  - On 11/27 a vehicle was reported stolen from 925 Sperry Rd, the vehicle had been locked, but its keys had been left in another unlocked vehicle on the property
  - On 11/28 a dirt bike was reported stolen from 1181 Long Hill Rd. Entry may have been made into the garage from a garage window that was reportedly locked. No signs of forced entry.
- **Theft from MV:** There were a total of ten reported thefts in November.
