- **Car Seats**-Officers conducted a total of eight (8) car seat safety inspections in October.
- **Serious MVA**-CPD Traffic Division responded to a car versus motorcycle accident with serious injuries at Highland Ave by Maple Ave, they were assisted by the Naugatuck Valley Collision Investigation Team

- **Commercial Burglaries**- Detectives began investigations into three Commercial Burglaries in October. On 10/14 Citgo gas station (626 Maple Ave) and Splash Car Wash (1123 Highland Ave) were burglarized, on 10/22 the Shell gas station (901 W Main St) was burglarized. All were smash and grab type incidents.
- **Missing Person/Death Investigation**-On 10/3 Detectives began an investigation into a missing person complaint from a Notch Rd residence. The missing person was found deceased and a death investigation was started. Detectives worked with the CT State Police Major Crimes, Central Division; and CSP took the lead on the case.
- **Juvenile**-Detectives and School Resource Officers began an investigation on 10/28 into an alleged threat to the CHS. This threat was deemed non credible.
- **Larceny**-Detectives began an investigation into the theft of a firearm from a vehicle at a Buckland Dr address.
- **Larceny**-Detectives began an investigation into a prior theft from Automotive Edge (1174 Highland Ave) by an employee.
- **Sex Assaults**-Detectives began two separate investigations into past sexual assaults that occurred in Cheshire. Both were referred to this department by DCF.

- **Pistol Permits-** Eight (8) background investigations for pistol permit applicants were complete.
