MINUTES, TOWN COUNCIL PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING, TUESDAY, JANUARY 28, 2020, 6:30 P.M., ROOM 210, TOWN HALL, 84 SOUTH MAIN ST., CHESHIRE, CT

Present: Tim Slocum, Jim Jinks. Absent: David Borowy.
Staff: Arnett Talbot

Meeting was called to order at 6:34 p.m. by Mr. Slocum. A quorum was determined to be present.

The Committee discussed the request to name a Cheshire Park trail or pavilion in memory of Mark Jardim, who died in the twin towers in 9/11. Mr. Slocum noted that the necessary three letters of request were received, and the matter was referred to the Planning Committee as part of the Naming Policy requirements. The matter has also been forwarded to the Parks and Recreation Department for their review.

Mr. Slocum and Mr. Jinks agree that the pavilion would be a more permanent and visible memorial than a trail, and like the idea of honoring the memory of a member of the Cheshire community who was an active Cheshire Park user.

Moved by Mr. Jinks that the Planning Committee recommends naming the Cheshire Park pavilion the "Mark Jardim Memorial Pavilion"; seconded by Mr. Slocum. Motion was approved unanimously among those present.

Mr. Slocum discussed the subject of a review of Committee role and process, explaining that Mr. Borowy had wished to discuss this as a new member of the Planning Committee, and wanted to determine how to add the topic of contingency plans to the Planning Committee or Council agenda. This matter will be covered in the next Planning Committee meeting.

Motion by Mr. Jinks, seconded by Mr. Slocum to adjourn at 6:50 p.m. Motion was approved unanimously among those present.
