Cheshire Town Hall and most municipal offices are closed to the public except by appointment only. Many of our staff are now working remotely, per Governor Lamont's Executive Order. We encourage you to communicate and do business with the Town electronically. However, if you have a need for a service that we deem essential and urgent, and which cannot be conducted electronically, please call or email the relevant department directly to set up an appointment in advance, so we can be sure there is a staff member available to assist you. Public safety direct services remain fully staffed. Trash collection will continue. The Human Services Department is available to assist residents with counseling or financial needs. Until further notice, no new public meetings will be scheduled.
