

MINUTES OF THE CHESHIRE AQUIFER PROTECTION AGENCY HELD ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2012, IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION, IN COUNCIL CHAMBERS, TOWN HALL, 84 SOUTH MAIN STREET, CHESHIRE CT 06410

I. CALL TO ORDER

VI. BUSINESS

1. Pending Registration – 210 East Johnson Avenue.

Mr. Voelker reported that this is in regard to Central Transport Inc. and a letter from Fuss and O'Neill was read into the record for registration for regulated activity in the aquifer protection areas, with a check of \$100 for registration fee.

A letter was read into the record from RWA, Ron Walters, regarding 210 East Johnson Avenue, which stated that the regulated activity involves maintenance

and repair of vehicles and fuel storage. RWA reviewed the registration, and it is complete.

Mr. Voelker informed the Commission that the application is complete, for oil and petroleum dispensing for the purpose of retail and wholesale of fleet use, and repair or maintenance of vehicles or internal combustion engines of vehicles. This is not a new permit, and the applicant is registering the use. A new use would not be let in.

MOTION by Mr. Cobern; seconded by Mr. Dawson.

MOVED that the Aquifer Protection Agency accepts the regulated activities registration for the following facility:
Central Transport Inc.
210 East Johnson Avenue.
