

MINUTES OF THE AQUIFER PROTECTION AGENCY HELD ON TUESDAY, MAY 28, 2013, IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION, IN COUNCIL CHAMBERS, TOWN HALL, 84 SOUTH MAIN STREET, CHESHIRE CT 06410.

V. BUSINESS

**1. Determining Regulatory Status in Aquifer Protection Areas.
The Outlets at Cheshire
1953, 1973, 1989 and 2061 Highland Avenue.**

Mr. Voelker advised that there is a limited amount of aquifer on the plan.

Commissioners and staff reviewed the plans. Areas 5, 6, 7 show the aquifer on the map; area 6 shows the south eastern corner of the property with an entry drive, some grading, and landscaping and proposed emergency access drive. This would be the limit of activities in the aquifer.

Mr. Voelker read the letter dated 5/14/13 from the Regional Water Authority into the record.

There is no reason for an aquifer permit at this time. The RWA does not require any additional review.
