

CAMP POLICIES & REGISTRATION INFORMATION

It is imperative that parents/guardians read the following Policies before signing a child up for a Summer Camp.

- Registration forms must be completed in full and accompanied with full payment in order to be processed. Online registration is available at www.cheshirect.org/parkrec. Do not fax registration form!
- The deadline to register for camp or extended care is 4:00PM on the Thursday before a session begins.
- If space allows, late registrations will be accepted until noon on the Friday before a session begins with a \$15 late fee per child.
- **The deadline for Session B of SunFun, Quinnetukit, Sassacus & Sachem (July 6-10) and the deadline for Afternoon Sizzler Session A (July 6-17) is Wednesday, July 1, a late fee will apply on Thu., July 2 and no registrations will be accepted Fri., July 3 because the office will be closed.**
- Any child who will/may need to take medication during the camp day must complete a Medication Authorization Form which is available online and at the Parks & Recreation Department. Any child who will/may need medication and comes to camp without the medication or the Medication Authorization Form will not be permitted to stay at camp.
- ***NEW* All children must have a completed medical form on file at least one business day before the start of camp.**
- Sibling Discount applies to SunFun, Quinnetukit, Sassacus, Sachem and Afternoon Sizzler. The first child pays full price each session, each sibling thereafter will receive \$15 off the full price of camp each session. Siblings must be enrolled in the same sessions at the same time to qualify.
- Refunds minus a \$15 administration fee per child per session will be given if notice is received two weeks prior to the start of the session. Refund requests must be in writing to the Director of Parks & Recreation.
- Transfers must be in writing with a transfer form two weeks in advance. The transfer fee is \$15 for one child and \$5 for each additional child. Transfer forms are available at the Parks & Recreation Office.
- Nonresidents are welcome, please add \$10 to the camp fee each week; the additional \$10 does not apply to extended care.
- Camps are held at their regular location even on rainy days. Children should dress for the weather. In case of severe weather, please call 203.250-2470 or check www.cheshirect.org/parkrec after 6:45AM. Information will also be available on Facebook (www.facebook.com/CheshireParksandRec) and Twitter (@CheshireParkRec). These will be updated throughout the day.
- All campers participate in all aspects of camp. We reserve the right to remove from camp children who do not participate in camp activities. We also reserve the right to remove children from camp for disciplinary reasons. No refunds will be given if your child is removed for disciplinary reasons.
- Children must wear sneakers, this includes on trips! No open-toed shoes, sandals, dress shoes, crocs or wheelies permitted. Water shoes are recommended during water games, at the pool and on the beach only. No bare feet at camp!
- Children must bring plenty of beverages and/or a refillable water bottle so they do not become dehydrated during the camp day. All campers should bring a snack. Campers at full day camps and at Afternoon Sizzler must also provide their own lunches. Pack drinks and food with ice as no refrigeration is available. On some trips campers will need to bring lunch money as no outside food is allowed. More information about trips is available within the specific camp descriptions and will be emailed with your receipt.
- Apply sunscreen before sending your child to camp and send a note with a bottle of sunscreen if you would like it reapplied by a counselor during the day. If your child can apply the sunscreen independently, then just send the sunscreen. Hats and sunglasses are also suggested as protection against the sun. Label your bottle of sunscreen; sharing will not be permitted!
- If you would like your child to wear/use insect repellent, then please send a note and bug spray to camp with your child.
- All items must be labeled with the camper's name. We are not responsible for lost or misplaced items. Found items will be brought to the Office on the last day of camp and remain there for two weeks. After that, remaining items will be donated.
- Campers may not bring any toys, games or electronics (including cell phones) to camp. This includes on trips. If a camper needs to call their parent during the camp day they can use the camp phone. If you need to reach your child during the day you should call the camp phone. Phone numbers are listed with each of the camp descriptions.
- The Ice Cream Truck comes to most camps after lunch each day. If your child would like ice cream, please send him/her to camp with money to buy it.
- At pick up parents/guardians must present a photo ID and speak to the child's counselor and sign the child out for the day. Campers will not be dismissed to anyone besides a parent/guardian or person indicated on the registration form without a note.
- Please be sure that your child arrives and is picked up on time. You may drop off 10 minutes before the listed start time and pick up 10 minutes after the listed end time without registering for Extended Care. Pay close attention to the camp times listed in this brochure and register your child for Extended Care if you cannot pick-up/drop-off at the designated times. If you sign up for both Before & After Care you will save \$10 off the total cost of extended care per child per week.
- Please take into consideration that any information that you can provide regarding your child's behavior will be greatly appreciated. Directors will be better able to suit the needs of each individual camper with this information.
- Parents/Guardians are always welcome to park their cars in the parking lot and walk to camp at any time.
- At Mixville no parents may drive up to the pavilion during the camp day (8:45a-3:45p). Staff will meet you at the gate during drop off and pickup times. At any other time during the camp day you must park your car in the lot and walk to the pavilion.
