

SUBJECT:

Project Completion Report - Partial Roof Replacement - Dodd Middle School

The PBC project, (Partial) Roof Replacement at Dodd Middle School complete.

The purpose of this project was to replace three sections of the roof system at Dodd over the science wing. All three roof systems were more than twenty (20) years old, had been repaired multiple times and were actively leaking. Due to the school construction timeline constraints and the deteriorating condition of the roof systems, the Public Building Commission requested a bid waiver from Council.

On April 12, 2022, A bid waiver (Resolution #041222-8) was approved by the Council to award New England Masonry and Roofing Company, a DAS approved contractor for roofing work, the contract to replace three sections of roof, totaling 33,000 square feet, in the amount of \$475,000.

The project was successfully administered by PBC Subcommittee Chair, David Arai and Subcommittee Member, Don Nidoh. The project was overseen by Richard Clavet, Facilities Manager and Vincent Masciana, Chief Operating Officer from Cheshire Public Schools.

Funding for the project came from capital account #20400-5800-01427.

The project was fully completed on August 5, 2022 with no change orders.

Suggestions for Improvements:

This was a well-managed and well executed project. Due to favorable weather conditions, New England Masonry & Roofing Company was successful in gaining installation efficiency, which resulted in realized labor savings from the original firm fixed price contract. Due to the availability of roofing materials and a continued window of opportunity, another 3,000 square feet of roofing was replaced over the south section of the library.

Recommendations:

The Public Building Commission highly recommends New England Masonry & Roofing Company for future projects.
