2023 Neighborhood Assistance Applications – Due June 2, 2023

The Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act (NAA) Tax Credit Program is designed to provide funding for municipal and tax-exempt organizations by providing a corporation business tax credit for businesses who make cash contributions to these entities. Each municipal agency or tax-exempt organization that wishes to participate in the NAA Program must complete in its entirety Form NAA-01. Applications are due by Friday, June 2, 2023 and must be submitted directly to the Town Manager's Office, 84 South Main St., Cheshire, CT 06410. Interested organizations wishing to learn more about the program and/or have specific questions should visit the State of Connecticut Department of Revenue Services website as the Town's role is primarily administrative.

Applications are approved by the municipality's governing body and forwarded to Department of Revenue Services (DRS). Once an organization is approved by the state, businesses can receive a credit of 60% of their approved contribution to certain programs (or 100% in the case of certain energy conservation programs) approved by the DRS.

Revaluation Information

The 2023 state-mandated town wide revaluation process has begun. Data mailers will be sent to all improved properties to confirm details. Participation of owners is critical, so we ask all property owners to correct and confirm the data and return the form.

Several inspectors from the revaluation company, eQuality Valuation Services LLC, will be doing onsite inspections as well. Vehicle information for these individuals will be posted on the Town's website and their information has also been provided to the Cheshire Police Department. All inspectors will have an identification badge.

Data collection will continue through September 2023. The new mill rate based upon the Grand List developed by this revaluation will be used for the July 1, 2024 tax bills. The Town's goal is to ensure that all property information is correct so accurate values can be applied.

Electronics Recycling Event

The Town is hosting a free Electronics Recycling Event on Saturday, March 18, 2023, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Quinnipiac Park, 1325 Cheshire Street. Residents may drop off their electronic recyclables, including computers/laptop/printer/keyboard/mouse/monitors; TV/VCR/DVD/remotes; telephone/cellphones; fax machines; scanners; iPods/PDAs; stereo equipment, cameras; tablet/eBooks; small appliances; lightbulbs; game consoles/controllers; and batteries.

The following items are **NOT** accepted: smoke detectors, car batteries, and appliances containing Freon, including AC units, refrigerators, and dehumidifiers. No other waste materials will be accepted.

- Building permit plans are being reviewed for 64 apartment homes at East Mitchell Avenue
- Whole Foods Distribution is completing a \$500,000 upgrade to their facility at 400 E. Johnson Avenue for two banana ripening rooms
- The Town received the States valuation of the 691 Conveyance property with a required sale price to the successful respondent of the to be issue Request for Proposal at \$2,085,000
- Stone Bridge Commons Lots 1, 5 and 6 aka the commercial component received final site plan approval last evening for approximately 135,000SF (see updated renderings below)






