#### New MYRec Recreation Registration System – Launching August 1st!

The Town is very pleased to be rolling out a new and improved registration system for all Parks & Recreation, Community Pool, ArtsPlace and Youth Services programming beginning August 1<sup>st</sup>.

Current patrons will need to go online to establish new customer accounts for their household, as the Town is changing system vendors. Patrons can also contact any of the participating Town Departments directly for additional assistance. This initiative will create one registration location for all programs across Town departments, simplifying access to information, programming, and facility use. The new MyRec system also comes with a fully customizable web page where information, forms, policies, news, maps, announcements, calendar, text/email blast alerts, photo gallery and more can be posted and updated live 24/7.

The new registration page (<u>http://cheshirect.myrec.com/</u>) is live beginning July 10<sup>th</sup> for patrons to begin creating their customer accounts.

#### **Expanded Local Elderly Tax Credit Bracket Follow Up Information**

Following the close of the application period for the newly expanded Local Elderly Tax Credit program, the Assessor's Office has reported that we received 28 *Single* applicants in the new \$57,200-\$74,700 bracket, totaling \$7,000 of credits issued and 34 *Married* applicants in the new \$61,200-\$80,000 bracket, totaling \$10,200 of credit. For a combined total of \$17,200.
