Dear Mr. Kurtz,

We have completed a Site Development Plan for the parcel of land known as Lot 2 at Orchard View Subdivision off Academy Road and Wiese Road. At the time of the subdivision approval, the development of the house, driveway, and septic system on this lot were outside of the 50' regulated upland review area. The plan as currently proposed includes a 20'-wide accessway to Honeypot Brook Pond, which is within the 50' regulated upland review area of approximately 1,000 square feet. There are no direct wetland impacts within this lot.

At this time, we are requesting a determination for the need of an Inland Wetlands and Watercourses application for this lot.


